Highlights

- Quarter II Update: Thirteen new patents and 17 licenses and options issued in second quarter. Over one hundred and ten new patents filed during the quarter and \$3.352 million in license income generated.
- OTM at Urbana licensed to LK4 Technologies web accessibility wizard software that provides a simple way to create standards compliant web versions of Office documents that are more accessible and usable for everyone, including people with disabilities.
- Both OTM offices continue to sponsor programs on intellectual property issues for the university community. Urbana OTM co-hosted a "Forum on Open Access, Alternative Publishing Models, and Author Rights" which attracted over 90 attendees. Keynote address was given by Provost Linda Katehi. Chicago OTM's program on intellectual properties attracted one hundred faculty and staff.
- UIC's Concept to Venture annual business plan competition awarded 1st and 2nd place to teams whose plans were built upon UIC technologies.
- An article featuring OTM's "IP landscape analysis" appeared in December 2007 issue of *Technology Transfer Tactics*
- *OTM offices attract international attention:* A group of French technology transfer professionals visited OTM to learn about UI's technology transfer methods.

- Majority of companies in the IETF now post-revenue, and a number of them are expected to be profitable within 12 months
- Several projects advancing through development pipeline with management team development and/or funding events:
 - **Tetravitae Bioscience** – Completed national searches/hires for CEO Jay Kouba (BP, Metabolix), VP Biology Steven Stoddard and VP Engineering Larry Karcher (both from ADM); identified partner for \$30 million Series B raise
 - **Riverglass** – Completed \$2.5 million Series B add-on; closed \$1.6 million federal earmark
 - **Nextumi**, - Saw explosive user growth for new ShareThis™ product, identified partner for \$15 million Series B raise.
