

Highlights for 3rd Quarter FY 2008

Two drug therapies based on University technologies reach important development milestones:

- Therapy for Alzheimer's Disease developed by **CoMentis**, a company established to commercialize technology from UIC and Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation, enters Phase I/II clinical trials.
- **SteadySleep Rx**, an IllinoisVENTURES supported start-up pursuing novel therapeutic treatment for sleep apnea, files IND.

IllinoisVENTURES funded companies receive significant co-investments and recognition:

- **Nextumi** received \$15 million external funding based on growth in demand for its ShareThis™ web-search product.
- **Tetravitae Bioscience**, a bio-fuel development company, received \$30 million funding.
- **Eden Park** a new startup based on innovative lighting technology developed by University of Illinois professor J. Gary Eden and associate professor Sung-Jin Park, received \$1.5 million in funding from a syndicate led by Illinois Ventures. The company appointed Philip Warner, formerly head of LED Marketing and Business Development for Philips, as CEO.
- **iCyt** received the *2008 Frost & Sullivan United States Emerging Technology of the Year Award*. The company also obtained commitment for additional funding.

Startup Companies Graduate from Incubators:

- **RiverGlass**, a startup located in EnterpriseWorks, expanded to facilities at the Urbana-Champaign Research Park and the Technology Park in DuPage County.
- **Chromatin** and **United Technologies** graduated from the Research Center at the Chicago Technology Park.

New Programs Launched to Support Student Entrepreneurs and Interns:

- IllinoisVENTURES launched the **IV10 Program** to support student entrepreneurs. Four student teams will launch software related startups this summer with mentoring from faculty, IllinoisVENTURES professionals and alumni.
- Collaboration announced with Mozilla Labs, a developer of platform for open source software development, to search nationally for student teams aiming to develop new open Web technologies for incubation in University of Illinois Research Park.
- Over 300 students and 30 Research Park companies participated in Student Career Fair at Urbana-Champaign.
