## IllinoisVENTURES

### Highlights

- Continued service process for IllinoisVENTURES, Illini ITEC, and Chicago ITEC client entities.
- Completed developmental funding for a total of 37 entities since 1/1/03, with over \$7.3mm in total funding to-date. Achieved over 6:1 in "leverage" of third-party investor and grant funding.
- Completed final closing for Illinois Emerging Technologies Fund, bringing total commitments to \$26.5mm. 38% of VENTURES general and administrative costs now offset by private sources (management fee).
- Achieved very high customer satisfaction for third consecutive year (>95% "meets" or "exceeds" expectations, >83% "outstanding" or "exceeds" expectations).
- Launched several new developmental efforts for Illinois-based businesses including DzymeTech, Inc. (UIUC), PsiTech, Inc. (UIUC), and Transplan (a collaboration involving faculty at UIUC, UIC and U of Chicago).
